Your main tasks will include

- Easy repair tasks on the machine

- Training of new employees
- Offering practical guidance and technical support for all employees
- Operating the cell sorter and providing support to operate other flow cytometers
- Supervision of the consumables (ordering and storage) and documentation of all procedures

- Practical experience and expertise in flow cytometry
- Interest in instrumentation and great technical skills
- Good communication skills in German and English
- High-degree of self-organization and ability to work independently
